VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATION

Certified Medical Review Officers (MROs) must be currently licensed physicians holding either a Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.) degree who have completed specific MRO training and a certification examination that comprehensively covers the elements required by the US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the US Department of Transportation (DOT). Certification is valid for 5 years and requalification training followed by a recertification examination is required to remain certified.

Additionally, to practice as an MRO in US federally-regulated drug testing programs, the MRO must be a licensed physician in a US, Canadian, or Mexican jurisdiction.
