

Department of Transportation (DOT) *Management Information Systems (MIS) Changes*

Reminder: MIS Reports are due by March 15, 2024

The Department of Transportation (DOT) sent an advisory notice on **October 26th, 2023**, stating that DOT-regulated employers required to submit annual drug and alcohol testing data will need to go through **Login.gov** to access the **DOT's MIS system** to input and submit the drug and alcohol testing data.

"What is Login.gov?"

- **Login.gov is a secure sign in service used by the public to access participating government agencies' systems, including MIS. Login.gov requires the user to set up at least one authentication method to secure their account."**

To submit your drug and alcohol testing results you will:

- **Register** at <https://damis.dot.gov> using the 32-digit activation code the DOT agency provides in their email. This will bring you to Login.gov where you will either "Sign in" to an existing Login.gov account or "Create an account".
- (From the Status Screen) **Click** "Enter" or Edit your Data under the Data Column.
- For DAMIS access, **only one email address per employer** may be used as the email address is the "key field for Login.gov"

Refusals determined by the employer and testing processed outside of the ITSA system are not provided in the statistical summaries. Testing events outside the ITSA system should be added to the MIS data before certifying.
